



## Zipline Devotion

### Verse:

James 2:14 - What good is it, dear brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but don't show it by your actions? Can that kind of faith save anyone?"

### Devotion:

Discuss the fun at the zipline today. Remind everyone how great the view was from the top of the tower – you could see everything! And talk about how exciting the ride was flying across the treetops to the other side.

Although the zipline was fun and exciting, did you struggle or have to stop on the way up the ladder? Was it scary once you made it to the top seeing how high you were? Was it hard to step off of the platform even though others told you it was easy?

Are you glad you went through the tough time of climbing the ladder and stepping off to enjoy the zipline? Would you do it again? I know I would!

Like the zipline, there are times in our lives when we are making a hard climb similar to going up the ladder; or we are faced with a situation of stepping out in faith but are scared of the outcome. God is in our life to help guide and teach us. If you can step off a 47 foot high zipline, you should be able to step out in faith and trust that God knows what is best for your life.

After riding the zipline, when you have flown through the air with a sense of freedom, you finally get to the end and your feet touch the ground. The staff tells you to follow the narrow path back to the tower. Once at the tower, you can choose to climb to the top again or seek a new path.
